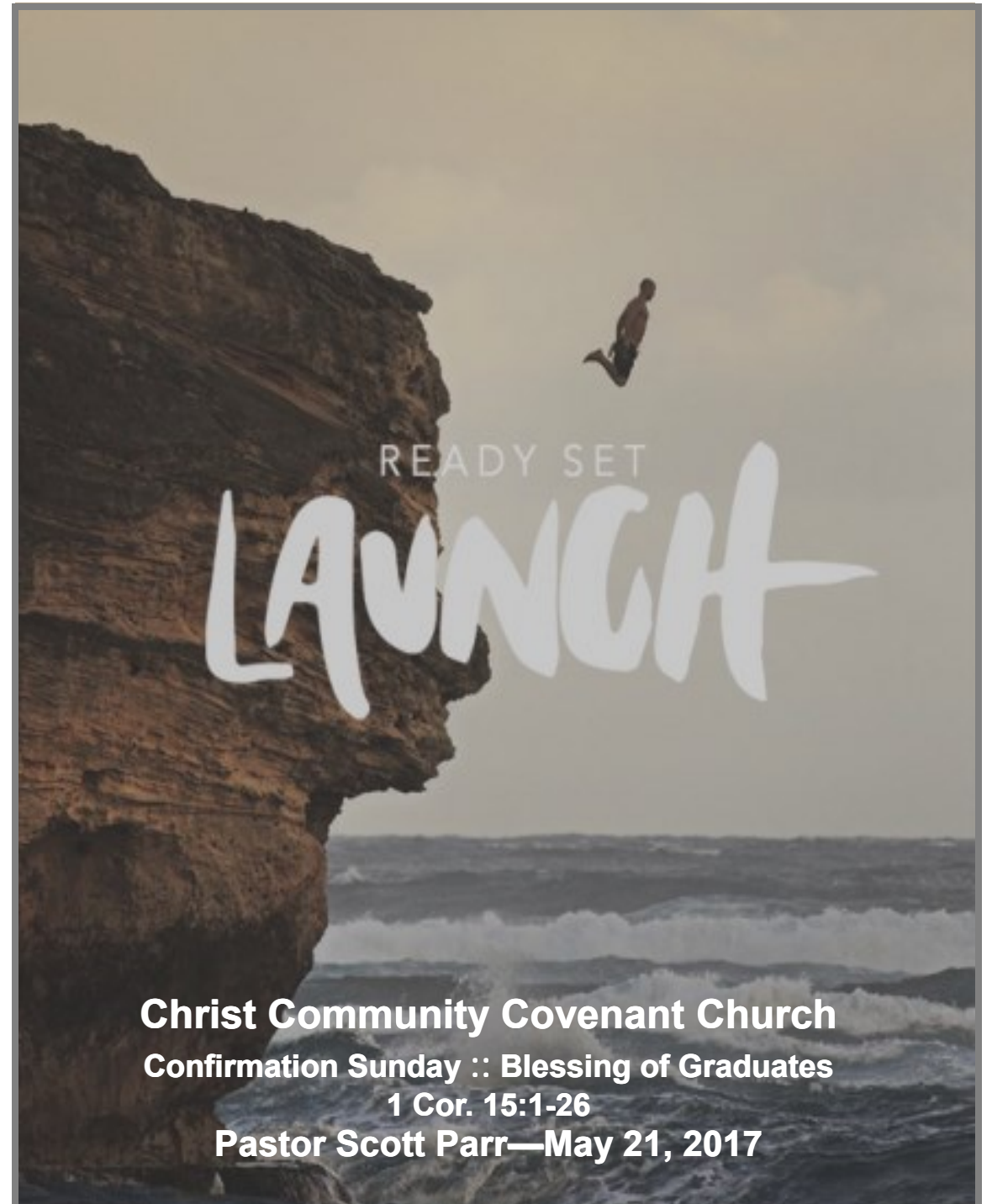

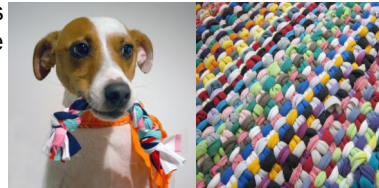

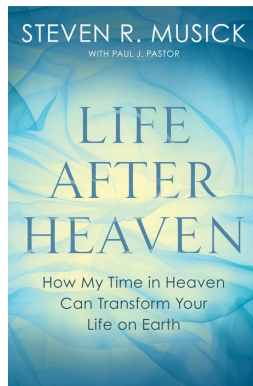

A word about donation drop offs—We LOVE donations! Your time, talents and treasure, for sure! We love it when we ask for food for Open Hands and Blessing Bags and you very generously respond! But...we're a little confused and concerned when items are just left on the porch, in offices, in the entryways, etc. We're not sure who they're from, if they're safe to pass on to others (food items especially), if they're for a certain person or charity—or it's just stuff you don't want anymore and think the church might "need" it.
